


- Became the new measure of green building on November 1
- Increased focus on health and wellness











This represents a net savings of **\$6,987,576,000** over the economic lifespan of LEED[®] certified buildings.

Net savings are the difference between the 33 year present value of savings and the green building investment.
This data is for 2275 LEED® certified buildings, representing 23,742,197 square metres in Canada.

In 2014, the green building industry employed **297,890** direct full-time workers, this represents more Canadians employed than in the *forestry, oil and gas,* and *mining* industries combined.
