

Geographical Context






240,000 Ha 30,000 people 330+ Country Residential Subdivisions

Project Background

- Community Sustainability and Development Plan
 - Combined ICSP and OP
- Heavy emphasis placed on community and youth engagement
- How to make municipal governance, land use, development and decision making exciting to youth?
- How to encourage buy-in from schools?


