



How EcoSchools certification works

Schools apply for EcoSchools certification by demonstrating achievements in environmental learning and action. Actions such as walking to school, bringing in a waste-free lunch, and promoting water conservation can earn a school points towards their certification. We assess each school based on a standard established over 10 years of benchmarking.
















ON AVERAGE, PLATINUM ECOSCHOOLS PRODUCE 57% LESS WASTE THAN NON-ECOSCHOOLS.




