



Clean Air Council 2019 – 2023 Declaration Actions



- 1. Getting the Municipal House in Order:**
Continuous improvement and progress reporting related to implementation of:
 - Corporate energy conservation;
 - Green procurement; and
 - Green fleets plans.

2. Advancing Low Carbon Financial Mechanisms:

- Especially as it relates to Development of Resilience Business Cases;
- Integration of Climate Change into Stormwater Plans/Fees; and
- Implementation of Distributed Energy Business Cases and Models.

3. Scaling Up Low Carbon Buildings: Through the uptake and transfer of:

- Green Development Standards;
- Implementation of an Energy Efficiency Retrofit Program;
- Increasing Resilience of Buildings to Extreme Weather Impacts; and
- Supporting Building Energy Disclosure and Labelling.

4. Maximizing Transportation Co-Benefits and Carbon Reductions:

Through the development and implementation of:

- Electric Vehicle/Low Carbon/Municipal Strategies;
- Advancement of Active Transportation Plans and Complete Streets/Vision Zero Policies; and
- Air Pollution Considerations in Transportation and Land Use Planning.

5. Incorporating Climate Change Considerations into Municipal Decision Making: Through the development and implementation of:

- Community Climate/Energy Plans;
- Integration of Co-benefits and Equity Lens' into Community Climate/Energy Plans;
- Policies that support the implementation of distributed energy projects;
- Integration of Climate Change into Official Plans;
- Increasing capacity and application of a Climate Lens;
- Integration of Energy; Climate Change and Natural Capital into Asset Management Plans; and
- Increasing Transparency related to Municipal Climate Change Decision Making.

6. Working Collectively Across Stakeholders to Increase the Understanding of the Links between Climate Action, Community Livability and Financial Sustainability.



Emerging Issues Clean Air Council Priorities: These would not be referenced in the CAC Declaration but would be prioritized in the CAC workplan:



- Carbon Budgeting & Carbon Disclosure
- Scan of Revenue Tools Used in other Municipalities
- Sharing and Autonomous Vehicle Policy Approaches
- First and Last km from Public Transit Strategies
- Emergency Response to Extreme Weather
- Urban Agriculture, Urban Heat Islands, Urban Forestry, and Air Quality (health and equity considerations)
- Green Job and Company Clusters
