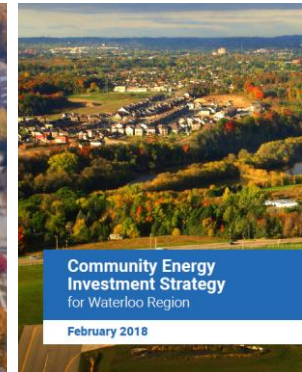

CEIS – Action Plan with ‘recommended’ actions

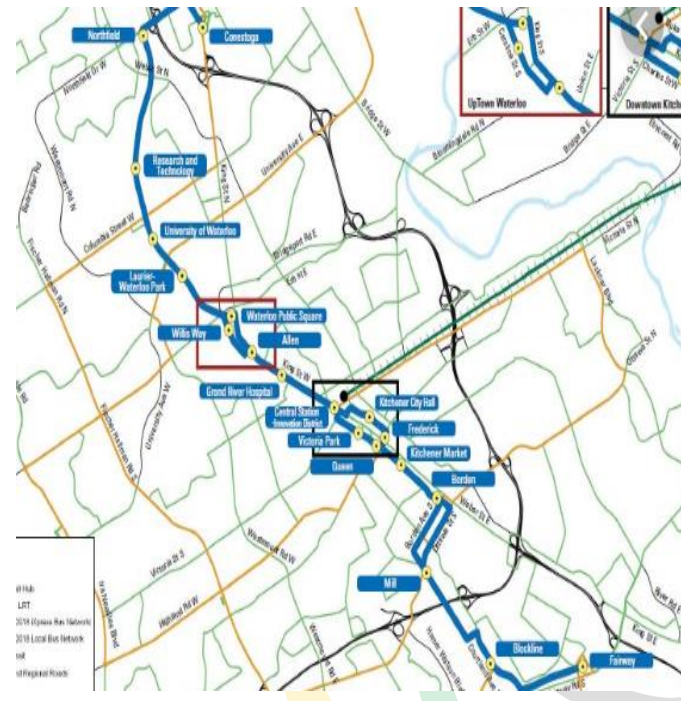
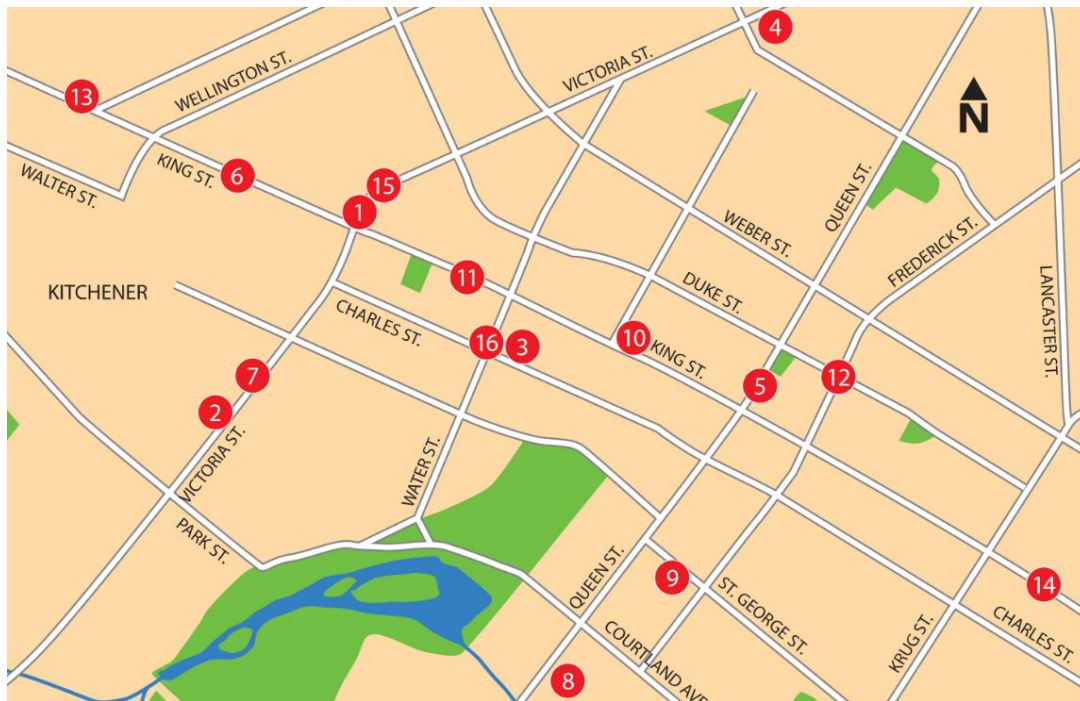
3 Year mandate to gain “momentum”
