

Formalize partnerships with municipal climate leaders

BurlingtonGreen Youth Network - We have been invited in the past to meetings. They used to organize large conferences 'for youth by youth.' Keynote speakers included Jane Goodall, David Suzuki, etc.

Burlington Youth Council - run by municipal staff during the school year. Members of Council and staff present to youth and ask for input.

Halton Climate Collective - GenerationGreen conferences and work each year - for youth by youth - strive to reduce community GHG emissions

## Tracking climate action decisions going to council.

"Climate Action" is very broad ... it's transportation (transit, active transportation); it's planning decisions (growth, etc.); it's asset management planning; forestry plans, etc. Would be difficult to collate.

Enbridge has requested that they be notified of all climate change reports going to Council. There is a mechanism for our Clerks office to do this.

Have kids give their municipality a climate change report card;)

Would this be GTA wide? One common calendar?
