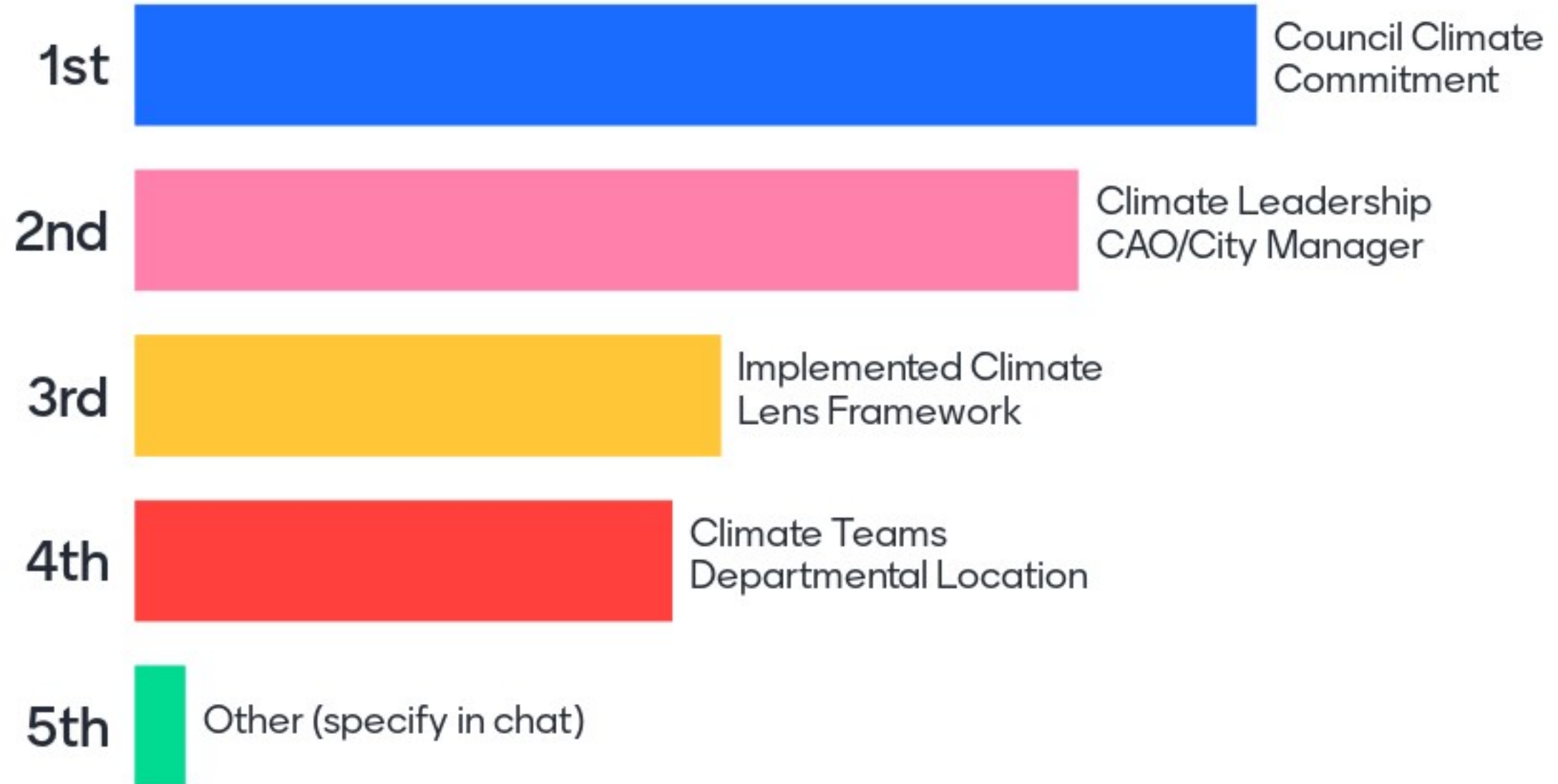


Which factors have the biggest role in supporting municipal climate ambition, resources and implementation?
